#### MERRYWEATHER MUSIC MUSINGS

One of the goals I have for each of my choir students is for them to achieve greater independence musically. However, through the years I've found that with the exception of those who have an extensive instrumental background (piano) most singers have a difficult time learning music on their own. This year, in hopes of addressing this issue we are learning to using a digital notation program called 'Noteflight'. This program allows singers to create audio rehearsal tracks to be used for individual rehearsal. Hi-Lites completed the 'Noteflight' course and as their final, sang a song at the Holiday Choir Concert that was not learned in class, but by each choir member individually. Hi-Lites did a fantastic job of performing this song for the first time, live and I feel a lot of confidence was gained by many. Luminosa and Virsonum will next have a chance to follow Hi-Lites and perform their 'Noteflight' final in the Festival Choir Concert.
